Job Summary:

Under general supervision, the Architectural Reviewer reviews construction documents and inspects facilities, and develops responses implementing the standards for construction projects which meet the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and related codes, state law, and standards. Serves as a consultant evaluating compliance with accessibility standards for new construction and alterations, program accessibility, and barrier removal issues; provides highly technical and professional architectural assistance by conducting critical reviews of architectural plans and specifications, onsite surveys and reviews of buildings and sites. Provides photographic and written evidence of accessibility compliance; assists in developing technical assistance materials and guidance; and provides detailed advice and guidance to top management, other architects within the agency, and other state and local governments entities, private firms and individuals. The incumbent also performs other job related duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

Completion of an undergraduate degree in Architecture from an accredited college or university <u>AND</u> Four (4) years of experience in architectural design, construction document preparation and review, building/fire codes analysis and implementation, and/or construction administration. Must meet the agency's requirements to be an authorized driver and possess the ability to travel statewide.

NOTE: If the selected applicant meets the minimum qualifications <u>and</u> is a registered Architect in good standing, the job title will be ADA Architect.

Travel

Travel throughout the State of Georgia, including overnight travel, is required.
