Position Overview

Position Description: Reporting to the Deputy CIO, the IT Enterprise Infrastructure Engineer ensures the integrity, availability, reliability, performance and efficiency of the network, applications and communications for the Georgia Building Authority (GBA), Georgia State Financing and Investment Commission (GSFIC), and the State Properties Commission (SPC). This position is responsible for the design, installation, maintenance, and retirement of the systems that are core to the organizations. They ensure that all relevant data is properly collected and stored including performance metrics, service levels, server status and both planned and unplanned system outages. The IT Enterprise Infrastructure Engineer participates in the planning and implementation of systems for all IT related projects. Responsible for evaluation and selection of infrastructure hardware and systems. Makes recommendations and assists in the implementation of changes to work methods and procedures to make them more effective. The IT Enterprise Infrastructure Engineer also performs other job-related duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications: Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in a related field **AND** Five (5) years of experience managing professional level staff **OR** Nine (9) years of experience **AND** Five (5) years of management experience at the level equivalent to area of assignment **OR** Five (5) years of experience at the lower level Sr Mgr, Business Ops (GSM012)
