Duties: Under general supervision, organizes, gathers, and supports the agency's database software application(s) and serves as the agency's information security officer. Serves as high level technical support to resolve database and system security issues.

Minimum Qualifications:

Undergraduate degree from an accredited college or university with a concentration in computer science or a related field and Three (3) years of experience in the generation, installation, and maintenance of database software packages, one of which should have been in direct support of a Database Management System. Experience with network and application systems security.

Preferred Qualifications:

Preference will be given to applicants who, in addition to meeting the Minimum Qualifications, possess the following:

Experience with SQL databases, Microsoft Sharepoint, Microsoft Access, Windows 2000/XP/2003/2007—operating systems and AD network, PeopleSoft, Microsoft Project, Primavera or other project management software packages. The following certifications are applicable to this position (other certifications may also apply): CompTIA Security+; GIAC Security Essentials; MTA Database; MCSA: SQL Server; MCSE: Data Platform; MCSE: Business Intelligence

Competencies:

Possesses strong knowledge of database reliant software. Additionally, must possess knowledge of relational database, project management and network system security requirements. Understands requirements and needs for producing and distributing information reports and dashboards. Possesses strong written and oral communication skills with the ability to read, analyze and interpret general business periodicals, professional journals, technical procedures, or governmental regulations; additionally possesses the ability to write reports and business correspondence.
